



**Wildcat Extension District
Crawford County 4-H
Scholarship**

All Crawford County 4-H Scholarship Applications are due to the Extension Office on July 15th annually. Applications will be reviewed by a committee.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the 4-H'ers Record Book, Application Form, and a Letter from a 4-H Project or Community Leader who works directly with the 4-H'er.

There will be a total of five (5) \$100 scholarships awarded within the county. The five (5) recipients will be announced during the Livestock Sale at the Crawford County Fair.

Applicants must be active 4-H'ers. An active 4-H'er is classified as being an active member of 4-H for a minimum of four (4) years.

Applicants must be planning to be a Full-Time student in the Fall of this year at either a Two (2) or Four (4) Year College or Post-Secondary Vocational/Technical School of their choice.

Recipients of the Crawford County 4-H Scholarship must complete the school year. If he or she does not, they will be required to return the scholarship money.

Please note: Applicants must turn in the Crawford County 4-H Scholarship, along with their 4-H Record Book and a Letter from a 4-H Project or Community Leader. All items must be turned in to the Wildcat Extension District – Girard Extension Office, 120 E. Buffalo, Girard, Kansas 66743 by July 16, 2020.
